Call for Papers for Symposium on Financial Intermediation and Corporate Finance

The Dutch Tinbergen Institute and the University of Amsterdam, in collaboration with the Banking Research Center at Northwestern University, will organize the 1994 edition of the annual symposium of the *Journal of Financial Intermediation*. The symposium will be held in Amsterdam, The Netherlands, from May 25 through May 28, 1994. Authors are invited to submit papers on issues pertaining to the interface between financial intermediation and corporate finance. Specific topics include, but are not limited to, international comparisons of financial systems including safety net, regulation and accounting issues, a firm's choice of public versus bank debt, role of intermediaries in corporate restructuring, the impact of the scope of financial intermediation on corporate financing patterns, and the role of financial intermediaries in the design of financial contracts used by corporations.
