### **MARTIN T. KATZMAN**

Martin T. "Marty" Katzman, a highly respected member of the American Risk and Insurance Association and its Risk Theory Seminar died in an automobile accident in December 1989. At the time of his death, Dr. Katzman was Senior Research Economist at Oak Ridge National Laboratory and Adjunct Professor of Economics at the University of Tennessee. A graduate of Harvard College, he earned the Ph.D. in economics at Yale University. Before moving to Oak Ridge, he taught at the University of California at Los Angeles, the University of California at Berkeley, the University of Sao Paulo, Harvard University, and the University of Texas at Dallas.

Dr. Katzman authored four books and over 100 articles on such diverse subjects as energy, public finance, regional development, pollution liability, insurance, and risk analysis. A former John Simon Guggenheim Fellow, he had held research awards from the S.S. Huebner Foundation for Insurance Education, the CPCU-Harry J. Loman Foundation, the Risk and Insurance Management Society, and Resources for the Future.

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
